

## SRCHA Stallion Stakes Rules

The Board of Directors of the SRCHA is pleased to announce the Annual SRCHA Stallion Stakes. For a nomination fee of \$500.00, any stallion owner, mare owner, or futurity/derby exhibitor/owner can nominate a stallion to the Stallion Stakes, making all foals sired by that nominated stallion eligible for entry in the annual Stallion Stakes. Also any Stallion that was sold and paid for during our Stallion Auction is automatically paid up for the Stallion Stakes Class. The Stakes will run concurrently with the Annual Futurity and Derby held in August of each year.

The annual nomination fee per stallion is as follows:

Nomination fee paid by August 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 2010.	\$500.00
Nomination fee paid after August 3 <sup>rd</sup> thru August 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2010	\$500.00 plus \$250.00 penalty

Distribution of nomination fees collected: 80% of nomination will be added to the purse as added money and 20% will be maintained for the program advertising and administration. Penalties will be included in fees collected. Any entry in the Open or Non Pro Futurity and Derby who is by a nominated sire to the Stallion Stakes program (whether “nominated” by paying the aforementioned nomination fee or by participating in the SRCHA Stallion Service Auction) is eligible to compete for the Stallion Stakes purse by paying the \$300.00 entry fee for the Stallion Stakes Class.

Separate classes will be offered for Futurity and Derby entries. The top composite scores for the Stallion Stakes entries in the Open and Non Pro Futurity and the top composite scores in the Open and Non Pro Derby will be eligible for the Stallion Stakes Purse. The total purse (80% of nomination fees plus the \$300.00 entry fee per participant) will be prorated between the Futurity entries and the Derby entries based on the total number of entries in the Stallion Stakes in each class. The payout for each event (one for Futurity and one for Derby) will be distributed according to the number of entries as suggested by the NRCHA rule book.

An incentive prize of 10% of the total purse will be distributed to the “sire nominators” of the highest 2 finishers of each class (Futurity and Derby) of the Stallion Stakes. The distribution of the 10% will be as follows, 5% to first place, 3% to second place, and 2% to third place. The “sire nominator” is either the person that paid the stallion nomination fee or, in the event the stallion became eligible through the donated breeding program, the stallion owner.

Stallion owners, mare owners and exhibitors – nominate your stallion of choice today so that his foals can compete for the substantial purse
